

We would love for you to choose us for your camping stay but before you do, please note the following...

### **CURRENT HEALTH POLICIES/GUIDELINES**

1. **Social Distancing.** Guests should maintain 6 feet social distancing between them and all non-family members at all times.
2. **Campsite Occupancy.** Limited to members of a single household or living unit (6 people maximum) **NO DAY or OVERNIGHT VISITORS ALLOWED.**
3. **Gathering.** At this time, we are not allowing group gatherings of people in common areas, such as roadways, rec area, beach, etc. If multiple families want to get together with recommended social distancing, they will need to do so on one campsite with a limit of no more than 10 people.
4. **Health.** If you or your family members are showing signs of illness, or have been exposed to someone that is ill, we ask that you refrain from camping with us.

We have added these policies and have taken enhanced health & safety precautions and **must ask that they be followed by all guests** while visiting our campground. There is an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 in any public place involving people. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and any guest(s) who are senior citizens or have underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. Please do not come if you are sick or experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19. By visiting Scenic Ridge Campground, you are voluntarily assuming all risks related to the exposure of COVID-19. Let's keep our community safe & healthy!

What is open/available... 😊

- Our upper bathhouse & port-a-potties as well as the restrooms & laundry facilities behind the camp store will be open. Our staff will be cleaning and disinfecting these facilities regularly as per CDC guidelines.
- Our Camp Store & Snack Shack will be OPEN for store window orders and pickup.

### **UPDATED: 6/10/20**

- Beach is now open for access to the swim area and should be limited to those wanting to swim or watch their children while in the water. As a courtesy for all, please refrain from sunbathing on the beach, please do that in the water on your personal floats, leaving room for all to enjoy the lake.

(PLEASE NOTE: WE RECOMMEND YOU BRING YOUR OWN FLOATIES OR PURCHASE AT CAMP STORE AS OUR INFLATABLES ARE NOT IN OR AVAILABLE AT THIS TIME)

- Personal beach chairs can be used to sit while watching your children. The benches in place will not be disinfected so the use of these is not recommended.
- 6' Social distancing between nonfamily members must be maintained.
- No group gatherings.
- Beach is only available to our campers. (No public passes will be sold at this time)
- All children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

**Please be courteous in the time you spend on the beach/in the water so that other families can enjoy some time as well.** We are hoping that with everyone's cooperation we will be able to keep the beach open.

Please remember...

- The Pier at the beach is for boat loading only, no jumping off, fishing or sunbathing allowed.
- To the right of the willow tree is the designated pet swim area.
- To follow all posted Beach rules.

**What is, unfortunately, not open/available...** 😞

- Inside service to the Camp Store and Lounge as well as outside seating
- Our Rec Area including the playground, jumping pillow, gaga ball, volleyball, horseshoe pits & rec tent

## **OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS:**

- Wearing personal face masks, frequent hand washing and keeping yourself and family up to date with all of the current CDC guidelines is recommended
- While we will be cleaning and disinfecting our restroom facilities regularly, we cannot guarantee or assure that our efforts will prevent contagious disease. We, therefore, recommend the use of your own toilet and shower facilities within your self-contained camping unit.
- Our Dump Station is available for use; however, we do recommend the use of disposable gloves while dumping your waste

Our goal is to make sure you and your family have the best getaway possible while promoting a safe family camping experience. As we temporarily will not be able to provide you with the same experiences as we have in the past, we do feel that your stay here can still be enjoyable...

- Stargazing, relaxing with family, cozy campfires, playing cards and games, telling stories around the campfire, and making some special memories
- Hiking the walking trails throughout the campground and visiting the County Park trails in the nearby area
- Fishing along the shoreline of Whitewater Lake or from your personal boat. (WI fishing license is required as Whitewater Lake is not a private lake)
- Biking along the WI Bike Way
- Watching the sunset over the lake. (Our ridge overlook is a great place to do so)
- Renting a Pontoon Boat, Kayak, Paddle Board or Canoe (check w/ camp office for availability) and enjoying some time out on the water.

### **CHECK IN PROCEDURES:**

To limit interaction between guests and staff and to provide a more convenient check in process...

- Prior to arrival, all of our guests will receive an email with the Camper Agreements/Waiver attached. To expedite the check in process, please print, complete, sign, scan and return through email. If you do not have access to a printer/scanner, that's no problem, we will have the paperwork here for you to fill out & sign.
- When arriving, please enter the campground at the main entrance and proceed up to your **reserved** campsite. After setup please stop down to the camp store to pick up your Check In Packet.

We will continue to update our policies when new information becomes available with the health and safety of our guests and staff being our highest priority. We hope that you enjoy your time with us and support us in our objective to abide by and follow all recommendations & guidelines set forth during these uncertain times.
